Subject: School facilities projects discussed at Tuesday's board workshop

Stu Markey, executive director of the Capital Improvement Bond Program, will be presenting the "Proposition S Five-year Schedule of Projects" at Tuesday's Board of Education workshop that begins at 9 a.m. in the Ed. Center auditorium. In addition to a revised schedule for the Prop. S program, the presentation will include several school projects for which board approval/direction is being sought.

The school projects include:

- Round Three of the Career Technical Education (CTE) projects (for which Prop. S would provide matching funds)
 - Hoover HS -- Academy of Information Technology facility (remodel)
 - Mira Mesa HS -- Broadcast Journalism facility (remodel) and Screen Printing and Computer Graphics facility (remodel)
 - SciTech @ San Diego HS -- Biomedical facility (remodel)
 - School of Creative and Performing Arts – Live Broadcast Studio facility (remodel)
 - Clairemont HS – Academy of Business and Technology (new facility)
 - **Henry HS – Production Studios (new facility), plus an auditorium (non-CTE facility)**
- Mission Bay HS – schedule
- Scripps Ranch HS -- air conditioning
- Lincoln area middle school
- Millennial Tech Middle School -- gymnasium/classroom facility
- Serra HS -- data center

Action will not be taken at the workshop on any of these projects. Many, if not all, will be going forward to the Nov. 2 board meeting for action.
