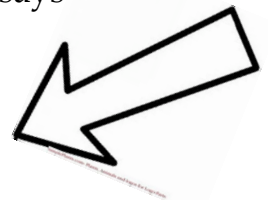
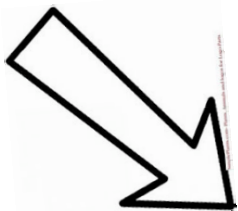
## College Admissions & Essay Writing Workshop

Get an early and effective start in AUGUST on the process of choosing and applying to college. Seniors graduating in 2010 are invited to participate in this limited enrollment six-hour summer workshop to accelerate the college admissions and admission essay process.

### Course Components:

- Guidelines and assistance in choosing colleges which provide best "fit" for each individual student
- How to best complete your UC application and write your UC personal statement for maximum impact. Also provides instruction in writing the *different* admission essay required by private universities. Students will write an admission essay and complete section 5 of the UC application between the two sessions. Provides opportunity for review and rewriting.
- Learn the application scoring rubric used by the University of California. How to use the UC application to your best advantage for the campuses of your choice - Includes completion of an actual UC application.
- Highly selective college admissions - How to put together the most impressive applications possible.
- Receive an assessment of your eligibility for need-based and merit-based financial aid.
- Bibliography and materials on best sources of information to successfully apply to the schools of your choice and receive all possible financial aid.
- Includes free follow-up online review of BOTH your UC application (including personal statements) IF done in advance in October AND your college admission essays

This workshop will be taught by Joe Ogilvie, retired Patrick Henry High Head Counselor and Scholarship/College Advisor and Chris Baldwin, recently retired PHHS multiple-subject AP teacher and College Board Consultant. Mr. Ogilvie read and scored applications for UCSD from 2003 through 2006.
