Emphasis on choosing the most comfortable, conducive atmosphere for satisfaction and success and a good match of school's academic profile and student's academic ability, achievements, motivation and work ethic. Includes guidelines and resources for research of college choices. A bibliography of recommended resource materials will also be provided.

Provides a survey of the UC campuses and a step by step review of the UC application procedures. The scoring rubric for UC applications will be discussed to enable participants to maximize the impact of their UC application. This includes writing guidelines for the UC personal statement as well as how to best complete segments of the application on honors and awards, extracurricular activities, and volunteer work/ community service. Materials and presentation will enable participants to maximize their students' prospects of admission to each desired campus.

Only 100 colleges are in the MOST competitive category, (admitting less than a third of applicants) but top students nationwide are all applying to them making admission extremely selective. Presentation and materials focus on how to develop a winning strategy for admission to highly selective schools.
